LAKE PARK OPTIMIST PAVILION FACILITY RENTAL INFORMATION

Thank you for renting Optimist Club picnic pavilion. The Park District prides itself on being a valuable community resource that adds to the quality of life for all residents of Des Plaines. We have many facilities that may be rented, including field houses, picnic pavilions, and rooms. A complete list, with fees, is available on our website, and at Park District facilities. We ask that you please read the important information below.

LOCATION: 2200 S. Lee Street. There is no telephone at this pavilion. Please go

to the Lake Park Golf Course Clubhouse, on the north end of the

park.

PARKING: Street parking on Lee Street, subject to City regulations.

ALCOHOL: Park District Code PROHIBITS any alcoholic beverages on any

park property. <u>Evidence of alcohol will result in loss of deposit and renter will lose rental ability through the Des Plaines Park District.</u>

WEATHER: No refunds will be issued due to inclement weather.

RESTRICTIONS: Bouncy houses are not allowed on any Park District Property.

Amplified sound or extra canopies/tents are not allowed. Patrons cannot bring their own grill, please use the grills that are provided by

the Park District.

EQUIPMENT: 9 picnic tables and 1 grill are available. Tables are anchored to the

shelter's floor. There is electricity at this pavilion. The electrical circuit can only handle up to 20 amps. The Park District is not responsible for damage to personal equipment if the circuit breaker

is tripped.

FISHING: Park District season or day passes are no longer required to fish Lake

Opeka. All Cook County and State of Illinois licensing requirements still apply. For the health of the lake, and to respect your fellow fishermen, please follow all posted fishing rules and creel limits.

SWIMMING: Is NOT permitted in the lake. This includes NO WADING.

PRIVATE BOATS: May not be launched, unless the owner has officially registered the

boat and checked in at the clubhouse, and paid the daily launch fee.

ANIMALS: All pets must be leashed.

CLEAN UP: It is the responsibility of the group to remove all food, table

coverings etc., prior to leaving the park.

DO NOT put hot coals in any trash containers, put in designated coal bins. *Failure to clean will result in loss of deposit and possible*

additional charges.

HOURS: Usage hours are as stated on your contract. All changes must be

arranged with the Park District office in advance.

PROBLEMS: Should you experience any problems with this facility, please

contact the Lake Park Supervisor located in the Golf Course Clubhouse at the north end of the Park or call the clubhouse: 847-391-5730. You can also call the Golf Center Des Plaines: 847-803-4653. The Golf Center is located at 353 N. River Road. Please be

sure to bring your contract with you, to verify rental.

WASHROOMS: Are located at the Memorial Pavilion, and are open from dawn to

dusk.

DEPOSIT: Deposit will be returned, in full, if no problems or damages

occur and agreement hours are not exceeded. If during or due to your rental one of the following incidents occurs, you will forfeit the deposit and may lose your right to rent from the Park District in the future. Noise complaint is issued; group size exceeds the State of Illinois Guidelines for gatherings. If excessive clean-up is required, a \$25.00 per hour charge will be incurred not limited by the amount of

your deposit.

RESPONSIBILITY: You agree to be responsible for any injury or damage to person or

property arising out of your occupancy, use or enjoyment of Lake Park shelter or the occupancy, use or enjoyment of any other agents, Licensees, invitee or any other third party. You agree that your deposit may be used, applied or retained in whole or in part to the extent required to pay for such injuries or damages, including but not limited to a minimum \$100.00 - \$250.00 charge for a false fire or police alarm. You agree to indemnify and hold the Des Plaines Park District harmless from any and all claims, demands, expenses liens, losses or liabilities (including reasonable attorney's fees and court costs) of any kinds whatsoever, arising directly or indirectly out of your occupancy, use or enjoyment of the center including that of

your agents, licensees, invitee or any other third party.
